<b>Purpose of data processing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Upholding the right of domestic authority</li> <li>• Legitimate interests, in particular: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Investigation in case of burglary, theft and property damage</li> <li>* Surveillance of high fire-risk areas</li> <li>* Evidence preservation</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Transfer of personal data</b>	<p>In principle, the data is not passed on to anyone unless one of the protective purposes has occurred. However, in the event of its occurrence, the data can be passed on to the investigating internal departments or to the investigative authorities for clarification.</p>
<b>Time period of storage of data</b>	<p>As a rule, the recordings are kept for 72 hours and then automatically deleted. In the event of an incident (see section on purposes), the relevant information is retained until clarification or until the end of legal deadlines, and the manually deleted.</p>
<b>Your rights – Rights of the concerned person under GDPR</b>	<p>Art. 12-23 of the GDPR regulate the rights of the data subject, i.e., your rights regarding the handling of your personal data. With respect to us, these are essentially:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Right to disclosure as per Art. 15 GDPR</li> <li>• Right to rectification as per Art. 16 GDPR</li> <li>• Right to erasure as per Art. 17 GDPR</li> <li>• Right to restriction of processing as per Art. 18 GDPR</li> <li>• Where applicable: Right to data portability as per Art. 20 GDPR</li> <li>• Right to object to processing as per Art. 21 GDPR</li> <li>• Right to complain: According to Art. 13 para. 2 lit. D of the GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority.
